Eligibility

- Any team (5 people max) of UH students, faculty or staff may enter the competition.
- Entries will be limited to the first twelve (12) teams that submit an e-mail to kmonaco@hawaii.edu with a statement of their "intent to compete" and names of team members.

Rules

- All trees must be created entirely out of recycled materials.
- No hazardous materials may be used.
- Trees must be no taller than three feet and no wider than 18 inches.
- A complete entry form must be submitted with the tree, to include team member names, affiliations and description of materials used.

Deadline

Completed trees must be submitted at the Bachman Hall downstairs lobby on Friday, December 4th between 10:00am and 11:00am.

Awards

- Winners will be announced on Friday, December 4th at 11:30am at Bachman Hall.
- Nominal prizes will be awarded to the most creative, best use of materials, and most inspirational.
