**SUBJECT: UPDATED EXECUTIVE POLICY (E6.201) TO REFLECT THE
REVISED TUITION RATES FOR THE SHIDLER COLLEGE OF
BUSINESS MASTER'S PROGRAM**

The University of Hawai'i tuition schedules previously promulgated via Executive Memorandum 09-04 are replaced with the enclosed document.

On January 28, 2010, the Board of Regents approved the revision of the tuition rates for the Shidler College of Business master's program for academic years 2010–11 and 2011–12. Pages 2, 4, and 5 of Attachment 1 have been modified to reflect this Board action. All other schedules promulgated in Attachment 1 reflect actions taken by the Board of Regents on May 19, 2005 and November 21, 2008.

At the Community Colleges, tuition is charged on a per-credit basis for all enrolled credits effective 2001–02. In accordance with University concurrent enrollment policy, students enrolling at multiple institutions/campuses during the same term pay the applicable tuition at each campus. Unless a special tuition schedule applies, regular day tuition applies to any credit course offered throughout the year for which a General Fund appropriation is authorized. Undergraduate resident and nonresident students enrolled in nursing, dental hygiene, business, and other UHCC health programs also pay a professional fee (see separate fee schedule). Undergraduate/Graduate resident and nonresident students enrolled in the architecture program at UHM also pay a professional fee (see separate fee schedule).

² With appropriate notification, individual UH Community Colleges may elect to charge up to the UHCC High, but not below the UHCC Low.
