“EXPOSED” UP NEXT ON KENNEDY THEATRE’S LATE NIGHT SEASON

The University of Hawai'i at Mānoa's Department of Theatre and Dance Late Night Theatre series continues with a double bill entitled “EXPOSED.” Comprised of two acts, “This is a Play” is directed by Amy Healey and “The Natalia Gallery” is directed by Rebecca McGarvey. “EXPOSED” will be performed Nov. 14, 20, 21 at 11 p.m. and Nov. 15 at 8 p.m. in the Earle Ernst Lab Theatre.

“This is a Play,” the comedic first act of “EXPOSED,” written by Canadian playwright Daniel MacIvor and directed by MFA directing candidate Amy Healey, lets the audience in on a secret. Viewers are privy to the inner dialogue of three actors as they perform a hideous melodrama about lettuce, love and mistaken identity. The actors' verbalized inner thoughts reveal their motivations, rivalries, personal agendas and attitude towards the performance and result in a broadly funny piece.

“The Natalia Gallery,” a dance project directed by BFA dance student Rebecca McGarvey, is a collection of pieces inspired by the architectural photography of Natalia Ibarra-Blomgren. Natalia discovered her love of photography with the birth of her first child, and has since traveled across the country capturing the beauty of architectural structures and striking landscapes of the United States. Choreographers Rebecca McGarvey, Sarah Jane Carlton and Tanya Somday expose their varying inspirational images of New York City rooftops, lampposts, and sidewalks through modern contemporary movement.
