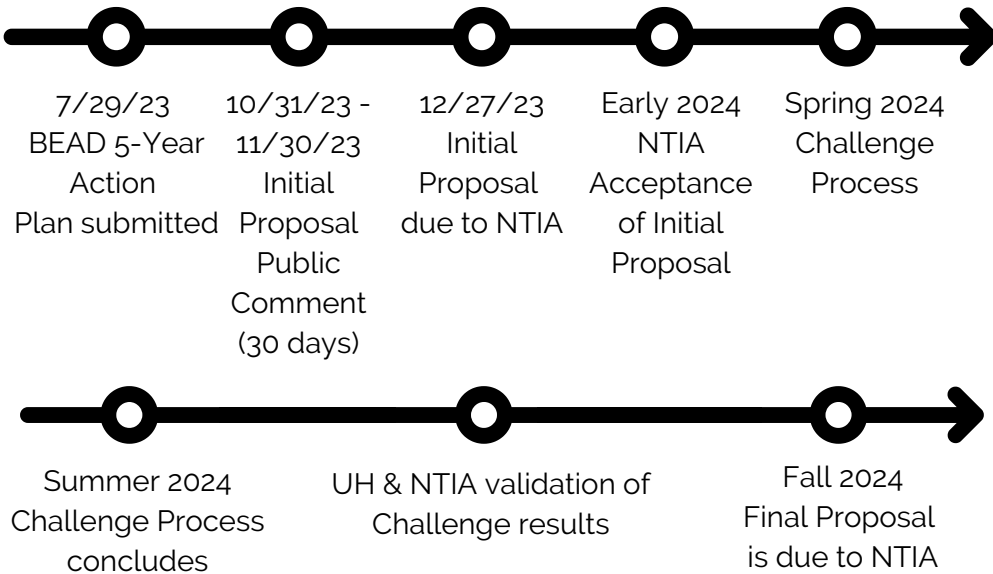


ABOUT THE INITIAL PROPOSAL

INITIAL PROPOSAL TIMELINE

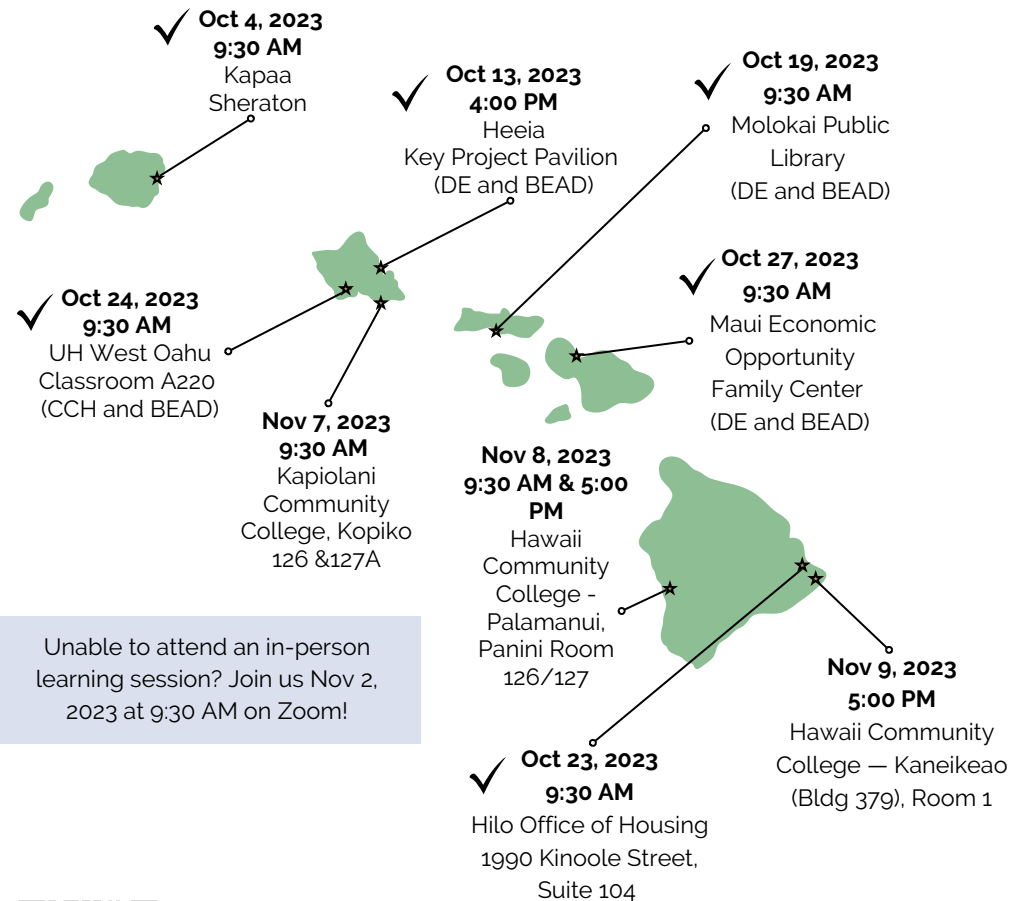
