HB 1904 – RELATING TO THE UNIFORM EMPLOYEE AND STUDENT ONLINE PRIVACY PROTECTION ACT

The definition of the term "protected personal online account" used in this bill excludes accounts opened or provided by an employer or an educational institution to be used solely or primarily on behalf of or under the direction of the employer or educational institution.
