HB 844 - RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII

The University of Hawai'i supports the intent of HB 844, which establishes a Network Improvement Community Task Force to develop K-12 Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) teacher education degree; appropriates funds for the establishment of a STEM Entrepreneuer-Resident at the University of Hawai'i Maui College; and appropriates funds for University of Hawai'i Maui College's Office of International and Regional Partnerships for study abroad programs.

There is an extreme need for STEM teachers on Maui and throughout the state, and this bill aims to address this issue. Extending study abroad opportunities will enhance student learning at UH Maui College.
