Thank you for this opportunity to testify in **strong support** of GM 616 and the nomination of Dr. Leslie Chun to serve on the Hawai'i Medical Education Council (Council).

Dr. Chun is the Chief Executive Officer of the Hawai'i Pacific Health Medical Group (HPH) which includes hundreds of physicians and advanced practice providers practicing in four HPH hospitals and related outpatient clinics throughout the State. As the former Chief Medical and Quality Officer/Vice-President of Medical Affairs at the Queen's Medical Center for 5 years, he helped launch the Queen's Advanced Quality Training Program and led the first ever collaboration with John Hopkins University to accelerate improvements in quality and safety.
