SB 2928 SD2 – RELATING TO EDUCATION

Thank you for the opportunity to testify on Senate Bill (SB) 2928 Senate Draft (SD) 2 relating to Education. The University of Hawai'i (UH) supports the bill to establish a working group to study and develop an implementation plan for career pathways in the agricultural sector.
