The two-year Kealahoʻimai Substance Abuse Counseling cohort at UH Maui College offers a series of 7 **FREE** courses (3 credits each) required to earn two Certificates of Competence that satisfy educational requirements for those wishing to become a CSAC. Students will learn basic counseling skills & approaches within individual, group and substance abuse treatment settings. Opportunities to practice skills will be offered through role playing and fieldwork in supervised settings. In order to earn the <u>CSAC professional certification</u> from the Hawai'i Department of Health, graduates will need to fulfill substantial additional supervised work verification hours as well as pass the state exam.

- ☐ Ages 18+ and resident of Maui County
- Admitted to UHMC for the Spring 2024 semester (admission application deadline: Dec 15, 2023)
- ☐ Course pre-reqs: either ENG 22 with grade C or better, or placement at ENG 100 (or instructor consent)
- ☐ Able to complete two semesters of fieldwork (200 hours per semester) at a local human services agency
