The Director of the University of Hawai'i (UH) Health Sciences Institute (Institute) provides leadership, expertise, and direction in developing and implementing strategies, procedures, and practices to foster a culture of excellence across UH health sciences research and education. The Director promotes interdisciplinary health sciences collaboration and innovative approaches among key internal stakeholders including Deans, Directors, faculty, researchers, staff, and external partners such as government officials, hospital executives, and community agencies. This single position class provides leadership and management of the Institute's day-to-day operations, overseeing all aspects of the administrative operations of the Institute including budget, fiscal and human resources decisions and matters.

As informed through collaboration with key stakeholders and the UH Health Sciences Council, the Director ensures the Institute is a dedicated clearinghouse and one-stop "portal" for information exchange and the unified voice for UH health sciences, education and research, and public health education. The Director will develop synergies through resource development, community engagement and representation, and advocacy and representation to ensure the Institute is equipped to identify and address public health challenges and disparities across health science disciplines, and to strengthen and expand the healthcare workforce through partnerships, educational pathways, and opportunities for clinical and practical training.
