DIRECTOR FOR ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND INNOVATION PROGRAMS AND THE PACIFIC ASIAN CENTER FOR ENTREPRENEURSHIP (PACE), SHIDLER COLLEGE OF BUSINESS, UHM

This is a single-position class that is directly responsible for providing leadership in the design, implementation, assessment and management of programs in entrepreneurship and innovation and the executive management of the Pacific Asian Center for Entrepreneurship (PACE). The Director exercises independent judgment and authority in setting priorities and formulating strategies, goals and objectives to insure the timely delivery of entrepreneurship and innovation programs through PACE and at the RISE facility. Through effective vision, leadership and direction, the incumbent works with considerable discretion to determine the methods, means and human resources to carry out the mission and goals of PACE.

Work in this class involves advancing the mission of the Shidler College and PACE to educate students from all colleges and schools at UH Manoa and across the University system in innovation and entrepreneurship; analyzes, reviews, and coordinates the development, modification and refinement of programs and offerings; manages the PACE budget and supervises preparation of financial statements and projections related to the Center; identifies and pursues grant funding opportunities from government, foundation, and private donations; and builds relationships both internally and outside of UH to develop and fund programs, opportunities and partnerships. Work is subject to review by the Shidler College of Business Dean for the accomplishment of program objectives. The PACE Advisory Board provides advice and consultation to the Director.
