Pursuant to APM Section A8.220, the Department requests a procurement exemption to purchase the following:

Description of goods, services, or construction:

Greens fees for a UH-Hilo Intercollegiate Invitational Golf Tournament in February 2015. There will be approximately 18 Division II teams from Hawaii and across the mainland United States. The tournament site would be on a prestigious, world-class golf course in west Hawaii Island. The tournament will run for 3 days: Practice round on day 1, then 36 holes on day 2, then 18 holes on day 3. UH Hilo serves as hosts and facilitators.

Estimated Cost:

\$40,000.00

(1) Explanation describing how procurement by standard competitive means is either not practicable or not advantageous to the University;

There would be no real advantage to seeking out the lowest prices because the participating teams pay their own greens fees anyway by way of the entry fee. Standard competitive means would not be practicable because procurement based on seeking the lowest prices could result in a golf course that does not fulfill the goal of hosting a prestigious tournament. A prestigious golf course would make this tournament more attractive to mainland schools. Consideration for the greatest value should be most important.

(2) Details of the process or procedures to be followed in selecting the vendor to ensure as fair and open competition as practicable:

The men's Head Golf Coach will contact golf courses in west Hawaii Island for price quotes. He will formulate a plan that is most reasonable, economical and meets the criteria for a successful, prestigious tournament. He will research at least 3 price quotes from prestigious golf courses on Hawaii Island appropriate for NCAA Division II Intercollegiate tournaments. He will secure a golf course willing to offer discounted rates and dedicate the necessary number of days and rounds of golf to hold this event. iya - o dhe
