April 11 and July 7 are the deadlines listed in the Academic Calendar, and it is the department's preferred deadline. The absolute final deadline for dissertation submission to ProQuest is Friday, May 16, 2025 by 4:00 pm HST for Spring and Friday, August 9, 2025 by 4:00 pm HST for Summer.
